Eligibility

Graduate members of the Weeks Major Midget Hockey Program and the current Weeks Junior 'A' Crushers who are enrolled full-time (as defined by the educational institution attended) in a post-secondary school education program (i.e. technical, liberal arts, sciences, social sciences at a community college or university undergraduate level) may apply for the *Scott Weeks Bursary*.

Award Criteria

To a program participant who has excelled academically, athletically and/or socially and who has made his best contribution to the hockey program. The Bursary will go to well-rounded, quality individuals of high character who are viewed as best fulfilling the objectives of the Bursary Program.
